



Instructions for e-poster presenters

1. E-Posters will be presented on iPad Pro's, there will be 10 iPad stands in the area to view all e-posters. Please use *Calibri* as font to ensure good readability. Well-designed figures, graphs and tables will generally increase the attractiveness of your poster.
2. The following display format will be available for e-Posters during Symposium dates:

SEARCHABLE DISPLAY: All e-Posters are indexed and can be searched for viewing on the designated iPad terminals.
3. The template for the e-Poster is a PowerPoint format. Please find an example [here](#) of how the poster will look on the iPad Pro.
4. E-poster presenters should use the following [PowerPoint template](#) to make the e-Poster.
5. All of the e-poster presenters will receive an email with a link to upload their e-poster presentation one week before the conference. It is pivotal to upload your final poster through the online link before the beginning of the Symposium. Please note that this PowerPoint will be saved as a pdf document to display on the iPad Pro.
6. Poster titles should be identical to the title of the corresponding abstract.
7. We suggest you mention the abstract code on your poster for convenience of the poster viewers.
8. Posters should show the names and affiliations of all contributing authors.
9. The use of generic drug names is encouraged (trade marks may be added between brackets the first time a drug is mentioned). The identity of experimental agents should be disclosed by means of brief descriptions, structural formulas and/or full chemical names. Please be advised that SSIEM2019 is attended by both prescribers and non-prescribers, so any form of promotion of prescription medicines is not allowed.
10. Any grants received in regard of the work described in the poster should be acknowledged.
11. Posters may be displayed throughout the duration of the symposium.
12. E-Posters will be on display continuously from **Wednesday September 4th between 8.00 hrs until Friday September 6th 13:30 hrs.**
13. Please note that any possible conflict of interest of any of the authors of the presentation must be clearly and prominently stated on the e-poster file. If there is no conflict of interest this should also be stated.



14. It is the responsibility of the authors to state any potential or actual conflict of interest in the content of their presentations. The SSIEM, as well as the Local and International Organising and Scientific Committees of the 2019 Annual Symposium cannot and will not assume responsibility for non-compliant presentations. Any interested party is referred to the SSIEM abstract submission and presentation guidelines, as well as the international and national rules and good practices on ethical transmission of scientific information.
